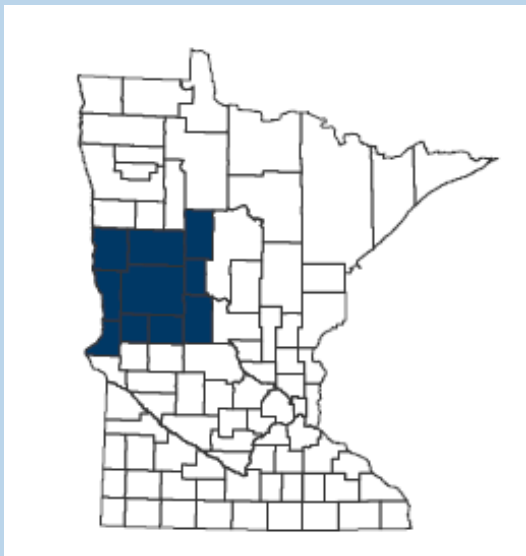

Five of the ten counties in Region 7 (Becker, Clay, Grant, Otter Tail and Todd) receive the wind energy production tax, accounting for 2.02% of the total taxable Wind production during the 2018 calendar year.

Only one county (Grant) received the solar energy production tax in 2019.
