
## **Tracking Continuing Education**

Did you know that you can track how many hours you have completed and how many you still need for the continuing education requirements? If not, let me show you how!

Your online assessors account, in the Assessor Licensing System, is where you can track your continuing education.

On the Home page there is a box titled "Continuing Education Requirements Met". This box is associated to your personal course records and will continuously accumulated course hours as you complete them through the current 4-year cycle (7/1/2020 - 6/30/2024).

Required hours are based on the requirements for the license level you had at the start of the licensing cycle (4-Year CEH Reporting Level).
