Updates (cont.)

- **Form Report Grader:** Mark Vagts has completed the form report graders training and will start grading reports.
- **Newsletter:** The 2021 April newsletter was sent out via email on April 21, 2021 to 893 assessors.
- Complaint Summary: Since March 2021, the Department of Revenue has received no new complaints. At this time, all investigations have been closed, and no new cases have been opened.
- **Assessor Licensure Standards:** The working group is working on the leadership segment and appraisal skills for SAMA standards.
- MAAO Curriculum & Assessor Standards Committee: Nothing new to report.

Discussion Items

CMA/AMA 7/1/2022 Deadline: Board members, MAAO, MAAP, and the Department of Revenue
have been discussing options for licensed individuals not doing assessment work going forward.
Multiple options were discussed, including possibly creating licensure indicators, looking to
future paths for non-assessing individuals, or moving assessors automatically to record-retention
after 5 years if the AMA is not achieved.

Gary Amundson made a motion that beginning July 1, 2022, any assessor who does not achieve their AMA after 5 years will have an inactive license status. Andrea Fish seconded the motion. The motion carried with two nays.

- Reminders for AMA Deadline Date: The board was asked if a reminder should be sent out to those that need to get their AMA by July 1, 2022. Andrea Fish moved to send out a list of assessors who need their AMA prior to July 2022 to all County Assessors. Matt Gersemehl seconded the motion. The motion carried.
- Vision Statement: Andrea Fish made a motion to adopt the Board Vision Statement: "Minnesota property assessment is equitable, uniform, and transparent." Matt Gersemehl seconded the motion. The motion carried.
- Board Goals: Gregg Larson and Joy Kanne presented the board's plan for work to accomplish
 during the remainder of this year. Jane Grossinger made a motion to approve the work plan for
 the remainder of 2021. Mike Reed seconded the motion. The motion carried.
- **Board Bylaws:** Gregg Larson and Matt Gersemehl presented an outline for the bylaws draft that addressed succession planning and other procedural matters. Gregg and Matt will work on finalizing the bylaws and bring to the July meeting for the board to review.
- Fundamentals of Real Property Appraisal Course vs Basic Appraisal Procedures: Jane Grossinger
 presented her findings on the comparison of these two courses. While this has some differences
 to other courses, the board determined it satisfied requirements to remain an approved licensure
 course.

Discussion Items (cont.)

- IAAO Assessment Administration: Andrea Fish presented her findings and opinion that this course meets the management & leadership SAMA course requirements. Matt Gersemehl made a motion to approve this course as a management & leadership course. Mike Reed seconded the motion. The motion carried.
- Minnesota Assessment Administration: MAAO cancelled the Fall 2021 offering of this course as only two assessors registered to take it.
- **Education Survey:** Joy Kanne, Matt Gersemehl and Lori Schwendemann presented an education survey to be sent out to county and city assessors. The board members discussed the survey, made some suggestions, and were enthusiastic about the survey.

Appointments with the Board

 DOR Updates: Jessi Glancey, Training & Outreach Coordinator from the Department of Revenue, shared her findings on the online standards and how they worked with virtual ALP, the plan for Ethics & PACE for the current licensing cycle, and the assessor standards being developed for SAMA. Gregg Larson will contact Jessi to go over the online standards, to work on improving them, and bring the revisions to the standards to the July board meeting.
